VII	Jesus falls a second time	people who cannot succeed in our educational system	
VIII	Jesus meets the daughters of Jerusalem	ministry to orphans	
IX	Jesus falls a third time	chronically unemployed	
X	Jesus is stripped of his garments	people fleeing domestic violence people fleeing disaster	
XI	Jesus is nailed to the cross	victims of genocidal violence victims of epidemic and pandemic	
XII	Jesus dies on the cross	<i>this station is left blank</i>	<i>this is left blank</i>
XII	Jesus' body is removed from the cross	people who minister to those whom society has rejected or forgotten	
XIII	Jesus is laid in the tomb.	people who minister to the dying
